Exclusion of liability:

The organiser is only liable in cases of intent and gross negligence. The organiser shall also be liable for negligent breach of obligations if this results in injury to life, limb or health.

The organiser is entitled to make changes to the event or cancel the event in cases of force majeure or due to official orders or for safety reasons. In such cases, the organiser shall not be liable to pay compensation to the athlete. The limitations of liability also apply to the organiser's vicarious agents and third parties used by the organiser in connection with the event. There is no legal entitlement to participate in the competition.

Data protection information

With your registration you provide us with personal data, which we collect and process as part of the organisation and implementation of the event on 28.10. - 04.11.2026.

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) stipulates that we must inform you about the type and scope of data processing and your rights at the time the data is collected. We provide you with this information below in accordance with Art. 13, 14 GDPR.

1. controller under data protection law (additionally, if appointed: / data protection officer)

2 Why do we process your personal data and why are we allowed to do so?

We process the personal data you provide in the registration form because this is necessary for the purpose of organising and running the competition. This is permitted by Art. 6 para. 1 (b) GDPR. In addition, we collect and process personal data because we have a legitimate interest as an association (Art. 6 para. 1 (f) GDPR). Such a legitimate interest exists, for example, in informing the public by reporting on the activities of the association. In this context, personal data including pictures of participants are published, for example, in the context of reporting on the club's sporting events, unless this conflicts with the overriding interests of the data subject. Beyond this, we only process personal data if you have given your consent.

3 What personal data do we process?

We collect and process the following categories of personal data from the following categories of data subjects for the purposes listed under 2:

Surname, first name, telephone number, email address,

Association affiliation

Participants

Surname, first name, address, email,

Telephone number, bank details

Speakers, trainers, organisers

Photos of participants, speakers, trainers, organisers

4. internal recipients of personal data

During processing, the data is passed on to the functionaries of the association entrusted with the organisation, insofar as this is necessary to fulfil the purpose.

5. external recipients of personal data

We pass on personal data to third parties to the extent necessary for the organisation and implementation of the competition. Personal data will also be passed on in the context of public relations work, in particular in the context of press releases and press enquiries.

6. duration of storage / deletion

The personal data will be deleted immediately after the end of the event, unless statutory retention periods and regulations and / or legal authorisations determine otherwise or the storage is necessary for internal follow-up of the event.

7 Your rights.

You have the following rights:

- the right of access under Article 15 GDPR,
 - the right to rectification under Article 16 GDPR,
 - the right to erasure in accordance with Article 17 GDPR,
 - the right to restriction of processing under Article 18 GDPR,
 - the right to data portability under Article 20 GDPR,
 - the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in accordance with Article 77 GDPR
 - the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
- Insofar as we base the processing of personal data on a balancing of interests (for legitimate interests of the association; e.g. the publication of photos), you can object to the processing in accordance with Art. 21 GDPR.
