Jurisdiction: Held in accordance with Motorcycling Australia G.C.Rs. Riders can only compete if they hold a national or one-day competition licence and must be a financial member of The Golden Beach Motorcycle Club (weekend membership available through entries), or a motorcycle Australia affiliated club

All riders and workers must hold a current subscription to Ambulance Victoria or a health fund.

CROSS COUNTRY FORMAT: Shot Gun Start

The track is sand, and the length is approximately 25kms long, riders are expecting to take 45mins to complete a lap. Whichever team completes the most laps in each class wins Race length will be 6 hours. Whichever team completes the most laps in each class wins.

CLASSES:

IRONMAN: OPEN TO ALL SENIOR RIDERS

PONY EXPRESS: 2 RIDERS 1 or 2 BIKES (Open to all riders)

PONY EXPRESS Novice: 2 RIDERS 1 or 2 BIKES (Riders must never have held a competition licence

3 MAN: 3 RIDERS 1 to 3 BIKES (Open to all riders)

FASTEST FAMLY: Immediate Family members Must have a Parent, (Parent must do a minimum of 2 laps) then Brothers, Sisters only (unlimited number)

ENTRY: (Per team) Entries capped at 300 riders ENTRY COST \$170.00 per rider

All riders will require a current Motorcycle Australia race licence, available through Ridernet.

Or a 1-day licence can be purchased when entering at the cost of \$90.00

All riders must be a member of an affiliated club.

1 weekend membership of Golden beach motorcycle club can be purchased when entering, at a cost of \$5.00

CHANGES TO ENTRY: you can make changes to your entry, by going back into your entry at Alpine timing

OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE:

IRONMAN: 2 Pit crew max

ALL OTHER CLASSES: No outside assistance, Team members may only touch the bikes.

Each team will be issued a wristband at sign on, this is the team batten and must be swapped over between riders at every change over.
